Project: Skills for life



This project is all about supporting young people who come from difficult and vulnerable backgrounds and who have found themselves in trouble with the law. These are the adolescents that most people will turn away, that will struggle with getting a second chance and very sadly some of them will probably end up back on the streets or in trouble with the law. The institute, Club Amigo Santo Angel which they attend work tireless to encourage restorative results and a chance of living a better and different life.

Among the activities that are run by the institute such as educational workshops, dance and sport, they have recently started running a course on bakery. This is a life changing course that not only teaches them the skills that will allow them to get a job, but it will also help them from going back to a life of crime. A youth we help is a generation we save.

I have listened to the students who have graduated from the course and its heart warming to hear the gratitude they express and the value they all give to what the course represents to them. Unfortunately, due to lack of funds out of the 100 adolescents there are resources for only 10-13 people.

Our aim is to raise enough funds to be able to get the bakery up and running in a stronger capacity, and to ensure more of these youngsters can have the opportunity to be part of the course. The main objective is that they receive the support and tools to be able to give them a better fighting chance in what is a very tough world for them.

If we all chip in as a community, without a doubt we can create life-changing opportunities for these young people who just need to feel loved, heard and supported.

Charity: Club Amigo Santo Angel



Club Amigó Santo Ángel belongs to the Pastoral Office for Children and the Family -OPAN- directed by the Congregation of Religious Tertiary Capuchins, (inspired by the Amigonian Pedagogy, with strict adherence to the Law of Childhood and Adolescence - Law 1098, committed to leading high-quality processes in the protection modalities and criminal responsibility system in the social context).

The Club Amigo Santo Ángel Program is derived from the Criminal Responsibility system for adolescents -SRPA Law 1098 of 2006. Currently, it provides service to an average of 100 adolescents and young people in conflict with the law, from Bogotá and its surroundings, who enter in compliance with the Non-custodial Sanction in the Internment modality in a semi-closed environment, referred by the specialized courts for children and adolescents of the judicial district of Bogotá.

The Club Amigó Santo Ángel program develops different psychosocial, technical, academic and support processes for families, with the purpose of managing possibilities of social inclusion and fulfillment of the goals in their life plans, in addition to preventing risk factors that lead to reoffending.

The youths receiving the support

The specific mission of Club Amigo Santo Angel is the **Prevention, Protection and Re-education** of children and adolescents between 16 and 25 years of age, considered to be in a situation of extreme poverty, with little schooling, marginalized, stigmatized and many victims of exploitation in different areas, in general it is a population that comes into conflict with criminal law, which in addition to many other social, family and personal factors places them at high risk and social vulnerability.

Club Amigo Santo Angel deals with adolescent lawbreakers, girls, boys, adolescents and workers and those who are also considered at high risk of social maladjustment, successfully enabling them to conceive a decent, useful and productive life project and achieve the start and/or the continuity of interrupted school and training processes.


Activity: Climbing Mount Snowdon
